Excellence in Break Through to Nursing Award to one chapter who strives for excellence in BTN on a national, state, and/or local level. The project will be judged on creativity, effectiveness (number or people reached), and quality.

Projects should accomplish one or more of the following:

- 1. Encourage recruitment and retention of students in nursing schools**
- 2. Target nontraditional as well as traditional students**
- 3. Promote transcultural awareness in nursing schools and in the community**
- 4. Use broad based strategies which consider ethnic diversity, gender, and age.**

Chapters applying for this award should submit a paper (maximum one page) describing the project and application form. The chapter must also submit a poster with brief overview and visual proof of the project. Paper, poster, and form should be submitted by 10:00 am on the day of convention.

Paper:

A one-page essay shall be submitted answering the following:

- Who group did the project target?**
- What did the project entail?**
- What goals did the project aim to reach?**
- Who participated in the project?**
- How successful was the project and what would you change next time?**

Poster:

A stand-alone poster shall be submitted that contains the following:

- Proof of the project (pictures, flyers, handouts, etc.)**
- Brief answers to all of the questions listed above**
- Name of School and Project**
